A bumper exhibition of Charlotte Perriand's pioneering furniture designs has gone display at New York's Venus Over Manhattan gallery.

The <u>furniture</u> designer - who was hired by Le Corbusier to oversee interiors on his projects - was a key player in the Modernist movement and had a career spanning 80 years.

Nearly 50 key projects are <u>on display in the gallery.</u> This includes a tubular steel chair made in partnership with the architect, and a six-sided table <u>Perriand</u> created in the late 1930s for her Montparnasse apartment. Its unusual shape was designed to fit more people around it.

A kitchen made for <u>Le Corbusier's</u> Unité d'Habitation and a room filled with furniture she designed for student accommodation in Paris are also on show.
